

Wairarapa-Bush Rugby Union Independent Board Members (4 Required)

The Wairarapa-Bush Rugby Union invites applications for four vacancies for the position of Independent Board Member. The four vacancies are for a two or three year term, commencing 6th May 2013.

The roles require a corporate governance focus, with responsibilities for setting the strategic direction for rugby in the Wairarapa-Bush region and monitoring the performance of all aspects of the business, while taking into account the interests of all relevant stakeholders. The selection panel will make their decision based on a set Skills Matrix that requires candidates with experience in: *Finance and Business *Legal and Human Resources *Sports Governance *Marketing and Revenue Generation.

Although knowledge of and empathy for rugby are beneficial, it is not necessarily a pre-requisite of the positions.

Independent Board Members must not be, or on appointment must immediately cease to be, either an employee of the Wairarapa-Bush Rugby Union, or a member of the Council of Clubs. The appointments are for an initial 2 or 3 year term and are appointed, not elected, positions.

All applications should include a CV, confirmation of independence as defined above, and an appropriate covering letter. They should be forwarded to:

COMMUNITY RUGBY REPORT

The Council of Clubs voted to start the senior competition on March 23rd as originally planned. The Senior B competition has been delayed by 2 weeks due to ground conditions. 5 grounds are considered suitable to commence the first 2 rounds. They are Memorial Park, Carterton, Gladstone, Martinborough and Greytown. COC delegates raised concerns about player safety in relation to the hard grounds. WBRFU as a result have inspected the respective club grounds. This will be ongoing until such time the grounds are deemed suitable for play.
