THE TACKLE: PART 1

Over the next few weeks I will explain the tackle so that you can understand that Law and all the requirements of all the participating players.

Firstly - "Is it a tackle?" A tackle is complete immediately the **ball carrier** is brought to the ground and **held** by one or more opponents. Brought to the ground includes going down on one knee or sitting on the ground or sitting on another player on the ground and being held includes when he is only held for a split second.

The players that bring the tackler to the ground and hold him are either **Tacklers** or **Tackling Assistants**. The only thing that differentiates these two 'types' are that the tackler also goes to ground at the tackle whilst the assistant does not. However, this is more than a subtle difference because the Law allows each 'type' of player to behave differently once the tackle is complete.

There can only be one ball carrier BUT there can be multiple tacklers and assistants.

When a tackle is completed, actions are required by all 'types'. The **tacklers** and the **tackling assistants** must release the ball carrier **and** the ball. The **ball carrier** must **pass** or **release** the ball. In releasing the ball he may **place** it or **push** it away from him. All the players who are on the ground must then move away from the ball and get to their feet.

At that point – ball on the ground; players rolling away – a competition for possession of the ball takes place.

On paper that sounds simple enough and, in most cases, it is the easiest part of the Tackle for a referee to rule on.

But that's enough to digest for this week – more next week.
