Have you noticed that at every game there is always someone who screams out at the AR (the Touchy) that he has missed a knock-on or throw forward or hasn't told the ref about some perceived misdemeanour by an opposition player. Most of those calls are quite rightly ignored by the ARs.

So what are the AR's priorities. Listening to sideline comments is not one of them.

The AR's first priority is judging when the ball is out and who will throw it in and from where. His second priority is being near the corner flag when things get tight near the goal line and his third priority is to report **Foul Play** incidents. Add to that, his job behind the posts and managing substitutions and all of a sudden you see why the knock-ons and forward passes are well down the list.

But the Touchy is allowed to **"advise"** the referee when he sees **CLEAR AND OBVIOUS** incidents which the referee **may have missed**.

CLEAR AND OBVIOUS – that's not a guess. That's not an off-the-ball issue that has no bearing on possession and it certainly doesn't mean a reaction because someone is shouting in his ear.

So if you are sitting beside someone who wants to give advice to the AR every minute of the game ask him to let them do their job. If the AR'S interfered with the game as often as spectators demanded, our game would be brought to a stand-still. Players don't want that. Referees don't want that. And neither do spectators.

Otherwise it will be getting dark before the final whistle. And then we'll all miss the try in the corner, wont we!
