- When hosting Junior games have the games side by side. Spectator traffic can cause considerable damage to fields at this time of the year.

Test Match Referee

I don't know if there will be much local interest in the Lions V's Wallabies first test at Brisbane this coming weekend? Of course there is an academic interest in which NZ coach will carry the day, but otherwise, the outcome means little to most of us.

But a select group of Masterton residents will be watching closely because the referee is also a New Zealander. Chris Pollock.

Chris grew up in New Plymouth where as an aggressive age grade half-back he was coached by Brent Gould who now lives here in Masterton and is a Senior Partner in the law firm Logan Gold Walsh.

Chris qualified as a teacher but his playing days stopped when he was injured. So he took to refereeing. In the late 1990's, trying to further his careers, both on and off the field, Chris moved to Wellington where he came under my guidance at Wellington Referees. In 2001, Chris was selected into the National Referee Squad where I coached him for 5 years until those duties were taken over by Lyndon Bray, Colin Hawke and Rod Hill.

And the final connection with Masterton is right there with his selection onto the National Referee Squad because it was our own Bob Francis who first identified that Chris had the potential to referee internationally and selected him into that 25 man Squad and under Bob's management team, Chris finally made full professional ranks and is now ranked amongst the top ten refs in the world.

So there really is a strong connection on Saturday night between Masterton and Brisbane. We all wish Chris well and, as is the aim of all referees, we hope he has absolutely no impact on the outcome of the game. Whatever that may be! **The Whistle Blower**
