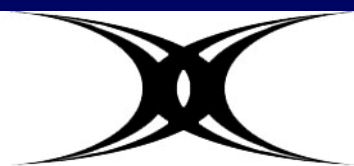

**Tip of the week:** Concussion Signs and Symptoms.

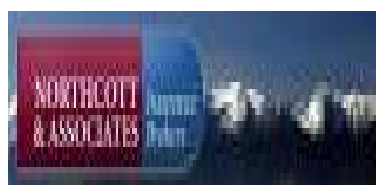
Make sure we have a manager/ coach who has done Rugby Smart 2013 asking the injured player the right questions and checking his symptoms.

### Front Row Substitutions and Replacements

I have been asked to clarify the law around front row Substitutions and Replacements.

Remember a **REPLACEMENT** and a **TACTICAL SUBSTITUTE** are different. A **REPLACEMENT** goes onto the field when an injury or a Front Row sin bin requires a player to leave the field. But a **SUBSTITUTE** goes on the field when his Coach requires.

**REPLACEMENTS;** An **INJURED** Front Row player can **ALWAYS** be replaced and the replacement must come from the sideline in this order.

- 1/ from any Reserve nominated as a **FRONT ROW REPLACEMENT** but who has yet to participate in this game, then;
- 2/ From a Front Row Player who has previously been 'subbed-off' in this game, and finally
- 3/ If neither of those category of reserves are available then the replacement can come from any of the other reserves who have **NOT** themselves been Subbed-Off in this game.

If the Replacement comes from (3) above, **UNCONTESTED SCRUMS** start.

An **INJURED** player can **NEVER** return to play in that game.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** At Senior 1 level in the Wairarapa, **ONLY** two Front rowers may be tactically subbed during the game and their replacement must come from the **QUALIFIED RESERVES** who have **NOT** previously been playing in this game. If there are no **QUALIFIED RESERVES** left on the sideline then no tactical substitution can take place and the player remains on the field.

But at levels below Senior 1, the Council of Clubs has dictated that ALL subbed players may re-enter that match – this is called Rolling Subs – and that ALL three front rowers may be subbed. However, any front row **SUBSTITUTE** must be a qualified front rower.

In all cases, a front row player can not be subbed off if no qualified replacement is available.
