

International Clearance Inbound

Player arrives or is arriving from Overseas

Player CAN NOT play until International Clearance has been received

Player completes an International clearance form from their Current National Union

The onus is on the player to seek his own clearance not the new Union

(Refer to their own National Union's webpage for form and email addresses)

Player also completes a NZ Senior Rugby Player Registration form and sends to Wai Bush Office

International Clearance form is sent back to their old club requesting they endorse the form and then forward the approved copy to the National Union for release.

The players National Union signs off and returns to NZRU

NZRU approve and return to Wairarapa Bush

Wairarapa Bush load the registration form and advise the Club

Player is free to play.

International Clearance Outbound

Player is returning from overseas or is leaving NZ to play Rugby

Player completes an outbound form

Completed form is forwarded to Wairarapa Bush office

Wairarapa Bush approves (once spoken with local club)

Completed form is forwarded to NZRU for release

NZRU advise old Union and new Union of clearance

Player is free to play overseas
