Union Chairman, Paora Ammunson says we are extremely disappointed that this has happened at this late and crucial stage of the competition. We are particularly disappointed for the other clubs that the reallocation of points will affect. Ammunson has confirmed that while the judicial process is complete and there will be no further impacts on the competition, he says that Union CEO, Tony Hargood has recommended that a further investigation be undertaken into the matter.
