Points Value	A different points system will be used: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Try 6 points</li><li>• Penalty Try (no conversion attempt) 8 points</li><li>• Conversion 2 points</li><li>• Penalty Goal 2 points</li><li>• Drop Goal 2 points</li></ul>
Time	Teams award a penalty after halftime or fulltime who choose to kick directly to touch must play the lineout.
