- The winner of any round robin match/matches played in that year between the two teams.
- The team having the higher point’s differential between the 2 teams.
- The team who scored the most number of tries between the 2 teams including tries scored in the final including tries in extra time.
- In the event that teams are tied at the end of a final and the winner is unable to be determined by applying criteria (a) to (e) above, the teams will be declared joint winners of the competition.
