#### **Ties in Finals**

In the event that teams are tied at the end of a finals match, the winner will be determined by the following criteria, which shall be applied in the order in which they appear until a result is determined.

- a. The winner following a further ten (10) minutes of extra time each way.
- b. The team scoring the most tries in the match (this includes any tries in extra time).
- c. The winner of any round robin match/matches played in that year between the two teams.
- d. The team having the higher point's differential between the 2 teams.
- e. The team who scored the most number of tries between the 2 teams including tries scored in the final including tries in extra time.
- f. In the event that teams are tied at the end of a final and the winner is unable to be determined by applying criteria (a) to (e) above, the teams will be declared joint winners of the competition.


